Two handsinks closest to manager's office are not receiving hot water. Ensure all handsinks receive a minimum of 100 F water.

CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5)(d). Handwashing sinks are properly equipped with hand soap, individual disposable towels or hand drying device, and signage; and conveniently located.

Violation #23. Date marking and disposition

Prepared pudding not properly date labeled. Corrected on site by school employee. Cheese in cooler not properly date labeled.

CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(2). PHF/TCS foods, which are RTE and held refrigerated for more than 24 hours, shall be properly date marked unless otherwise exempted.
